iPads are a tool which engage students and promote opportunities to embrace new technologies while enhancing learning and encouraging creativity.



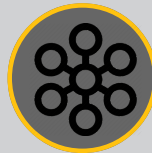

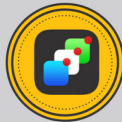
